POINTS FOR IN HAND, RIDDEN AND YOUTH HI-POINT AWARDS

CATEGORIES & POINTS:

CATEGORY 1: ENDURANCE, PLEASURE RIDES, COMPETITIVE RIDES & LE TREC

(a) Pleasure rides up to 50km (30 miles) - 1 point per km / 0.6214 points per mile.

(b) Le Trec – Points as per Category 5 (see table below).

(c) Competitive Rides (any competitive ride where there are speed and vet controls):
Completion of course – 15 points. PLUS Points per grading:

1 – 40 points, 2 – 30 points, 3 – 20 points, 4 – 10 points

(d) Endurance rides Affiliated: Completion of course – 25 points. PLUS Placings as per category 3. (Any unaffiliated endurance rides should be marked as per category 1a or 1c, dependent on whether vet checks in place at the event.

(Conversion factor for miles: 1 km = 0.6214 miles – do **NOT** round up, use the full 4 decimal places).

Points for categories 2, 3, 4, 5 & 6 are shown in the table below.

CATEGORY 2. FEI, BHS, BD or BSJA Affiliated competitions– e.g. Combined Training, Dressage, Show Jumping, Endurance, Reining etc.

CATEGORY 3. Championship & County Shows (includes USA-UK European Championships, Equifest, RLS, BSPA WCoC, CHAPS-UK Champs etc.).

CATEGORY 4. Ridden & In Hand Showing. E.g. Hack, Riding Horse, Road Hack, Hunter, Hunter Hack, Youngstock, Veterans, Working Hunter, Riding Club Horse, Sports Horse, Best Skewbald/Piebald, Western Pleasure etc. plus any non-affiliated class listed in category 3. Excludes any class listed in category 5.

CATEGORY 5. Utility Showing - C&T, Best Rider, Family Mount, Best Colour Markings, Western Trail, Showmanship, Concours D'Elegance, Horsemanship, Western Riding, Western Reining (unless FEI affiliated) etc. **These classes cannot count towards the hi-points/championship status**, but do count towards their own awards (see separate page)
