

**Show starts 9am – indoor Ashford Arena.**  
Classes open to any breed, unless otherwise specified. **Foreign Breed** – any breed that is non-indigenous to the British Isles (partbreds to be a minimum of 25% foreign breed).

#### **IN HAND CLASSES – 9am start**

**Classes 1 – 6 open to Purebreds only.**

1. Morgans – any age
2. Saddlebreds – 3 years & under
3. Saddlebreds – 4 years & over
4. Saddlebreds – British Bred

#### **C1 Saddlebred In Hand Championship**

1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> from classes 2, 3 & 4.

5. Appaloosas – any age.
6. Spanish & Lusitano – any age
7. Saddlebreds – partbred, 3 years & under.
8. Saddlebreds – partbred, 4 years & over.
9. Saddlebreds – British Bred

#### **C2 Partbred Saddlebred In Hand**

##### **Championship**

1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> from classes

**Classes 10 – 14 open to Pure or partbreds.**

10. Foreign Breeds – 3yrs & under.
11. Foreign Breeds – 4yrs & over, Mares.
12. Foreign Breeds – 4yrs & over, Geldings.
13. Foreign Breeds – 4yrs & over, Stallions.
14. Skewbalds & Piebalds, any age or sex.

#### **C3 In Hand Championship**

1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> from classes 1 – 14. Additional Award for Best

Youngstock (3yrs & under).

#### **20 minute BREAK**

#### **HUNTER CLASSES**

**Hunter Pleasure** – traditional English tack, snaffle, Pelham or double bridle (similar to

**Riding Horse, Show Hunter or Show Cob classes**). To be shown at walk, trot (working), medium / extended trot, canter and hand gallop.

**No individual show required in hunter**

**classes, except class 24.**

#### **RIDDEN CLASSES**

**15. Baby Green** – First year of showing under saddle or not to have won a ridden class. Any breed or tack, including training. Walk & trot only.

**16. Limit Hunter** Any breed, not to have won more than 6 hunter pleasure classes.

**17. Novice Spanish & Lusitano** English tack, snaffle bridle, not to have won more than 2 ridden Spanish / Lusitano or Iberian classes. Pure or partbred.

**18. Saddlebred Hunter Pleasure**

**19. Morgan Hunter Pleasure**

**20. Ridden Skewbald & Piebald**

English tack, any breed.

**21. Amateur Rider Hunter Pleasure**

Any breed

**22. Open Spanish & Lusitano** English tack, may include all movements. Pure or partbred.

**Short show required.**

**23. Road Hack.** Hunt seat or saddle seat, any breed. To be shown at walk, trot, extended trot, canter & hand gallop & to halt on the rail & walk off on a loose rein.

**24. Appaloosa Hunter Pleasure**

**25. Open Hunter Pleasure** Any breed.

**C4 Hunter Championship.** 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> from classes 16 – 22, 24, 25 & the highest placed hunt seat horse from class 23.

#### **LUNCH**

**Classes after lunch will NOT start before 1pm, but may start later.**

**26. Concour's D'Elegance** In hand or ridden, walk only, period or traditional dress – judged purely on turnout. Any breed.

**27. Spanish & Lusitano Parade** Spanish or Portuguese tack, pure or partbred. Come and strut your stuff – emulate the atmosphere of the Golega Fair where horses parade for the audience, giving you the chance to show off your horse in the most entertaining way. Enter on left rein.

#### **28. Paso Fino Pleasure**

Horse should be a pleasure to ride, calm & responsive and gaits should be performed evenly & consistently.

**C5 Spanish & Lusitano Championship.** 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> from classes 17, 22 & 27.

**USA-UK Gold Level SASH award presentation** will be held after this championship.

#### **WESTERN CLASSES**

**Western** horses may be shown 2 handed in a snaffle/hackamore/bosal or 1 handed in a curb bit.

To be shown at walk, jog and lope. Extended jog and extended lope can be asked for in the Amateur and Open classes.

**29. Gaited Open Breed** Come and strut your stuff – similar to class 27 – parade your horse for the audience and show off your horse in the most entertaining way. Enter on left rein.

#### **30. Limit Western Pleasure**

Not to have won more than 6 classes in western pleasure. Any breed.

**31. Saddlebred & Morgan Western Pleasure**

#### **32. Open Breed 3-Gaits**

To be shown in walk, "gait" and canter.

**33. Amateur Rider Western Pleasure** Any breed.

**34. Open Western Pleasure** Any breed.

*Classes 33 & 34 will be judged together but pinned separately*

#### **35. Paso Fino Performance**

Like Pleasure (class 28), but horse to show more spirit & collection in the execution of his gaits.

**36. Western Horsemanship** Any breed, pattern to be ridden first and then top horses to show back on the rail at walk, jog & lope.

#### **37. Saddlebred 5-Gaited Pleasure**

**C6 Western Championship.** 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> from classes 30, 31, 33 & 34.

#### **SHORT BREAK**

#### **38. Saddlebred 3-Gaited Park & Morgan**

**Park Saddle** (Saddle seat) shown at park walk, park trot & canter. Pads & weights (to 16oz) allowed.

#### **39. Morgan Classic Pleasure Saddle**

#### **40. Saddlebred 3G Country Pleasure**

*Classes 39 & 40 will be judged together but pinned separately.* (Saddle seat) Entries should be plain shod (no pads) & shown by amateurs only. Shown at flat walk, trot, extended trot & canter.

#### **41. Morgan Pleasure Saddle.**

**42. Saddlebred 3-Gaited Pleasure** (Saddle seat) Shown at flat or animated walk, trot & canter.

**43. Natural Gaiters** Open to any gaited breed.

Will be asked to gait on a loose rein to demonstrate a natural gait.

**44. Amateur Rider Saddle Seat Pleasure.**

#### **45. Open Saddle Seat Pleasure**

*Classes 44 & 45 open to any breed and will be judged together but pinned separately.*

**C7 Gaited Championship.** 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> from classes 28, 29, 32, 35, 37 & 43.

**C8 Saddle Seat Championship.** 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> from classes 38 – 42, 44, 45 & highest placed saddle seat horse from class 23.

**C9 Amateur Rider Championship.** 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> from classes 21, 33, 39, 40 & 44.

#### **C10 Saddlebred European Ridden**

**Championship** Open to all Saddlebreds who have been placed in classes 18, 31, 37, 38 & 42.

#### **C11 Grand Saddle Championship.**

All Champions & Reserves from C4 to C10.

#### **Advance ENTRY FEES**

**All classes: £15**

**4 or more classes: £10 per class**

Advance entries close 27<sup>th</sup> April

**Entries on the day - £15 per class**

*Entries on the day will also incur a £10 administration fee if horse has not pre-entered at least one class & all day entries are CASH only, unless prior arrangement made with Show Secretary.*

#### **PLEASE READ**

**Morgans:** Top 4 horses from each Morgan class qualify for the **AMHA Morgan Grand Nationals** in October. Morgan classes open to purebreds only.

**Saddlebreds:** Points from this show count towards qualification at the **Kentucky State Fair World Championship Horse Show** in August. Ridden Saddlebred classes open to both pure & partbreds. Purebreds in classes 2 – 4 must be ASHA or USA-UK registered. Additional rosettes will be presented to the highest placed Saddlebred in C3, C4, C6, C7, C8, C9 & C11. *Classes 2, 3, 4, 18, 37, 40 & 42 include European Charter Club Challenge classes – see website for details.*

**Spanish/Portuguese Horses:** Horses entering the in hand section of this show wearing a serreta must have a throat latch. Pure & partbred horses must be registered with their relevant registries – BAPSH or LBSGB.

**Skewbalds & Piebalds:** Top 3 horses in classes 14 & 20 qualifier for **BSPA World Championship of Colour** this August. Stallions 4 years & over must be BSPA registered, licensed and graded in order to compete in these 2 classes.

**ALL ENTRIES to enter on the left rein at TROT (jog or corto), including in hand, except Baby Green, Concour's D'Elegance & Western Horsemanship - enter at walk. No individual show required, except class 22. The judge will not ride in any class.** In hand horses to trot to end of first rail and line up nose to tail. You will then be pulled forward for individual inspection. Ridden classes will ask for walk, trot / jog and canter / lope (and maybe more depending on the class), reverse (change the rein) and then the same on the right rein. Rein back is usually asked in the line up in pleasure classes. **Allow 5-10 minutes per class – please arrive earlier rather than later so as not to miss your class.** **Classes after lunch will NOT start before 1pm, but may start later. Please be ready in the warm-up ring one class before you are due to show, to assist the Gate Steward.**

**PLEASE READ**

Most classes are **qualifiers** for **Royal London Show** (restrictions apply) – see website for more details. Cards will be available at the Secretary's Desk on the day – please remember to collect them before you go home. The covered outdoor arena has been booked all day and is to be used as a warm up area. Please do not use other areas. Please park cars, trailers and lorries considerately. Stabling is available on site and should be booked directly with the college – see separate entry form. Advertising is available in the show programme – copy deadline 1 month prior to the show. This event has been organised for USA-UK by a selected committee. Neither the committee, USA-UK or its representatives, or the owners and staff of Warwickshire College accept any responsibility for any loss, theft or damage whatsoever to any animal, item or article associated with the show or for any accident or injury to any item, person or animal howsoever caused. Although every effort will be made to adhere to the printed schedule, the organisers reserve the right to combine, cancel or change the running order of classes on the day if the needs arise and to refuse entry without specifying the reason. The United Saddlebred Association would like to extend a big thank you to everyone involved with the organisation and running of this show.

**Saddlebreds:** Indication of participation in the 2010 European Charter Club Challenge classes **MUST** be made in advance on the entry form. These classes will run concurrently with the Saddlebred classes at this show.

**Allow 5-10 minutes per class. Show starts 9am – all classes follow on – to aid the gate steward you should be ready in the collecting ring one class early. Please do not email the day before the show – you will not get a reply until AFTER the event!**
