AWARDS EXPLAINED

There are a number of awards (all year end) that you can take part in:

- **ALL of the USA-UK Awards** (our awards) are open to USA-UK members with USA-UK registered horses (we do run awards for non-Saddlebreds and non-members too). Some awards are FREE (hacking scheme, promotional scheme) and for some (the ones from competitive results) there is an annual fee to take part. No further fees are required regardless of how many categories you are eligible for. The Hacking Log Book, Promotional Scheme Log Book and Hi-Point Log Books are all available to download from our website – you fill them in during the course of the year (our competition year runs 1st Jan to 31st Dec) and then return them to our Hi-Points Co-Ordinator.
- **The ASHA (in America, our Parent Body) run State Pleasure Awards**, open to purebred ASHA registered horses that are owned by ASHA members and is FREE to take part in. The United Saddlebred Association-UK runs these awards in the UK/Europe on behalf of the ASHA. They are based on performance results in Saddlebred and specific World Breed and nominated classes and based on a hi-point system. At the end of each year USA-UK sends to ASHA the list of winners in the various categories and the State Pleasure Awards are posted to USA-UK to be presented to the various winners at our AGM and Convention.
- **The ASHA run a Hi-Point Program.** This is open to both pure and partbreds and is FREE to take part in. Horses must be registered and the owner and the rider must be an ASHA member for points to count. In addition the show must be nominated prior to the event (on the official ASHA form) and results submitted to ASHA within 10 days (with the exception of sport horse competitions such as dressage). For info, USA-UK nominates ALL the major shows in the UK holding Saddlebred and/or Foreign Breed classes and submits the results (if provided by the show organisers). We are happy to nominate ANY show that you want – just let us have the details and we will ensure the correct forms are used etc. and the show is listed on the ASHA competition database.
- **The ASHA run a sport horse hi-point scheme.** As before this is open to both pure and partbred Saddlebreds, who must be ASHA registered and the owner must be a current ASHA member. There is also an initial one-off \$25 registration fee for this programme. Competitions do not need to be nominated in advance, but results must be submitted on the correct ASHA FEI forms, signed by each show secretary/judge.
- **The ASHA have also brought out a new Ambassador Programme.** This is open to Purebreds only, who must be owned by a current ASHA member. There is no fee and points can be earned from every activity imaginable, from having a public lesson, to writing an article, to taking part in a horse show. Entries can be as an individual, as a barn (stable – the manager must be an active ASHA member) or Charter Club. Points that can be earned and forms to use are enclosed and we encourage all of you that are eligible to fill them in and send them off at the end of the year to the ASHA. We will be keeping a record of all the activities we (USA-UK) undertake as Charter Club and submitting our form too.

AMERICAN SADDLEBRED BREED AMBASSADOR PROGRAM SPECIFICATIONS

- Winners must be current members of the ASHA.
- Horses used in Breed Ambassador activities must be purebred American Saddlebreds to the best of the owner's knowledge, but need not be registered with the ASHA.
- The competition year for the ASHA Breed Ambassador Program runs from January 1 to December 21 of the calendar year. All point tabulation information is to be received by one of your regional charter clubs by midnight of December 21.
- Participants are not required to be members of the charter club collecting the data, although it is encouraged.
- Participants must compete in one Region only. Your nearest charter club (that's USA-UK for everyone in the UK) should seek out data, but it is recommended to make contact with your nearest club during the year, and again in December to verify points earned. This club might not be in your state/country.
- International participants should submit to the nearest Charter Club – for UK this is ourselves (USA-UK) and for Scandinavia countries it is ASHA-Scandinavia. All other international participants may select from one of the following 3 charter clubs:- USA-UK, ASHA-Scandinavia or VERSA.
- Points may be submitted to the club member via telephone, mail, in person, e-mail, fax, or any way of transmission acceptable to the club member collecting the information. Please confirm receipt of the information.
- Keep an activity log on the back of the chart. Winners will be asked to send in a list of their promotional activities for the year.
- The ASHA is not responsible for errors or omissions in the collection of data.
- Each region may have one winner with the highest points in each of the following categories: INDIVIDUAL AMBASSADOR (individual ASHA member) BARN GROUP AMBASSADORS (A group from a certain barn. The director must be a member of the ASHA) CHARTER CLUB AMBASSADOR (The ASHA charter club in the region with the highest point tally).
- The charter clubs must send in the forms for the winning Ambassadors only to Brenda Newell at the ASHA, b.newell@asha.org before midnight on December 20.
- The ASHA understands that there might not be a winner in each of the three categories for every Region.
- In the case of ties, recognition and prizes will be awarded to each high-point earner in the category.
- Regional winners will be awarded a cloth banner for display purposes, which the winners may keep permanently. Regional winners will also receive mention on the ASHA website, and the results will be made available via press release to breed-focused magazines. Winners who would like a small web ad on the ASHA site may also send in their 2" x 2" ad to b.newell@asha.org, and the ad will run for a minimum of 3 months sometime during the calendar year. Charter clubs may choose to provide additional prizes for winners, which will be announced at their discretion.
- The World's Champion Breed Ambassadors will announced at the ensuing ASHA Convention, with ONE winner in each of the three categories. This will be the highest point-earner from the 13 Regional winners. Winners in attendance will be speaking in the seminars.
- World's Champion Breed Ambassadors will receive an additional fabric banner, a 1" x 6" ad on the home page of the ASHA website for the calendar year, and be named in a press release to the breed-focused media. The ASHA may announce additional prizes at its discretion.
- It is very possible for multiple parties to get points for the same activity. Example: The charter club I belong to initiates a club function where Saddlebreds are to participate in the ABC Cure for Alzheimer's Charity Trail ride. I get points for taking my horse, Joe's Barn where I keep my horse gets points because they talked several of us into going, and my charter club gets points for organizing the event. Everyone wins.
- For the purposes of this program, an "Open Breed Show" will be defined as any horse show not intended for– or primarily attended-by American Saddlebred owners. Examples would be the Tri-County Paint Horse Show, the LSAC Arabian Horse Show, Morgan Club shows, 4-H shows and the like.
