Classes will not start before times show up until 1PM – after this time classes will run on from one another.

ALL classes open to PURE & PART Foreign Breeds unless otherwise stated.

10.10	7. Foreign Breeds – Mature Stallions , 4 years & over. (A) Pure & (B) Partbred, will be judged together but pinned separately.	17. Foreign Breeds Youngstock In hand – 3 years & under. (A) Pure & (B) Partbred, will be judged together but pinned separately.
10.20	8. Foreign Breed Broken Coated & Dilutes In Hand – Any age. (A) Pure & (B) Partbred, will be judged together but pinned separately.	18. Friesian In hand – Pure, any age.
10.30	C1 World Breeds In Hand Championship – 1 st & 2 nd from 1A, 2A, 3, 4, 5, 7A, 8A, 10A, 12, 13, 14A, 15, 16, 17A & 18. C2: Open Foreign Breed In Hand Championship – 1 st & 2 nd from 1B, 2B, 6, 7B, 8B, 9, 10B, 11, 14B & 17B. C3: Supreme In Hand Championship: Top three from C1 & C2. Awards to all.	

Please see schematic layout for position of rings. Ring 1 is the main indoor arena. The covered outside arena is to be used as a warm up and collecting area and half of it in the morning will be used for the Ring 2 in hand classes. If sufficient **advance** entries are received, we will hire the large outside (uncovered) arena for the morning where we will relocate Ring 2 and the harness classes. Please check nearer the time as to the layout on the day.

	Ring 1: Classes will not start before times shown up UNTIL 1PM after this time classes will run on.
Until 11	Warm up for harness classes in the outside covered arena: Ridden horses please do NOT use this arena during this time.

11.10	20. Open Harness – ANY BREED
11.20	21. Fine Harness – ANY BREED
11.30	C4: Driving Championship – 1 st & 2 nd from 19 – 21.
11.40	22. Champagne Class – ANY BREED.
11.55	23. Concours / Heritage Class – ANY BREED. Lead rein & in hand allowed. In hand and ridden pinned separately if sufficient entries.
12.05	24. Youth Walk/Trot – ANY BREED. Lead rein allowed. To include special awards for Best Junior Youth, 13 years & under and Best Senior Youth – 14 – 17 years.
12.15	25. Restricted Walk/Trot – ANY BREED. First year of showing, or not to have been placed 1 st more than 6 times in any ridden class (including walk / trot). Lead rein allowed.
12.25	26. Walk/Trot – ANY BREED. Lead rein allowed. Exhibitors only allowed to enter ridden classes 22 – 30 if they enter this class.
12.35	C5: Walk/Trot Championship – 1 st & 2 nd from 24 – 26.
12.45	27. Foreign Breeds Open Walk Trot.
1.00	28. Intermediate Canter Class Pure & Part Foreign Breeds. Canter only asked for on right rein one horse at a time. Ideal for those introducing canter to their horse's show ring performance.
1.10	29. Snaffle Bit Class. Pure & Part Foreign Breeds, ridden in a snaffle or bosal.
1.20	30. Limit Ridden Foreign Breeds. Pure & Part Foreign Breeds.
1.35	31. Ridden Foreign Breed Broken Coated & Dilutes. Pure & Part Foreign Breeds. Appaloosa Horses will be judged separately if sufficient entries.
1.45	32. Morgan Park Saddle. Pure.
1.50	33. Ridden Natives & Drafts. Pure & Part Foreign Breeds.
1.40	34. Open Western Pleasure. Pure & Part Foreign Breeds.
1.50	35. Morgan Pleasure Saddle. Pure
2.00	36. Parade Class. Pure & Part Foreign Breeds. Any show tack – show off your horse's best movements.

2.10	37. Masters Foreign Breed (Rider 40 years & over) Pure & Part Foreign Breeds.
2.20	38. Ridden Foreign Breed Veteran (15 years & over) Pure & Part Foreign Breeds.
2.30	39. Paso Fino Open Performance. Pure & Part

4.25	51. Morgan Hunter Pure & (52) Saddlebred Hunter, Pure & Part. Judged together, pinned separately.
4.30	C6: Ridden Saddlebred Championships: 1 st & 2 nd from Saddlebred ridden classes (40, 49 & 52) and the highest placed Saddlebred from class 34.
4.30	C7: Paso Fino Championship: 1 st & 2 nd from Paso classes (39, 45 & 50) (ONLY If sponsored – if not these competitors eligible for the Breed Championship C8).
4.40	C8: Ridden Breed Championship: 1 st & 2 nd from breed specific ridden classes (excluding any breeds that have their own ridden championship) – 31(A), 32(M), 35(M), 39(P), 42, 43, 44, 45(P), 46(M), 47, 50(P) & 51(M) 31A – 1 st & 2 nd Appaloosa if pinned separately in class 31. 32(M), 35(M), 46(M) & 51(M) – if no separate Ridden Morgan Championship offered, 1 st & 2 nd Morgans from these classes to come forward to the C8 Championship. 39(P), 45(P) & 50(P) – if no separate Paso Fino Championship offered, 1 st & 2 nd Pasos from these classes to come forward to the C8 Championships.
4.50	C9: Open Ridden Championship: 1 st & 2 nd from all other ridden classes (non breed specific) – 29, 30, 31, 33, 34, 36, 37, 38, 41 & 48.
5.00	C10: Morgan Ridden Championship – 1 st & 2 nd from Morgan classes (32, 35, 46 & 51). (ONLY If sponsored – if not these competitors eligible for the Breed Championship C8).
5.05	C11: Youth Championship - top 3 from class 24, plus the winner of any “Best Youth Rider” rosette at today’s show
5.10	C12: Supreme Ridden Championship: C & R from C6 – C10. (OR if no Paso or Morgan Championship, then top 2 from C6 and top 3 from C8 & C9).
