Points are accumulative for members' registered horses and will be counted towards their lifetime achievement awards. **Non-Registered & Non-Saddlebred Horses / Non-USA-UK members are welcome to take part in both the In Hand and the Performance divisions with their horses, but the scores will reset to zero each year.**

## How we calculate the points:

### In Hand Award & Performance Showing Points (not including Utility Classes)

Category (a) **Championship & County Shows** Points Table

Place	1st	2nd	3rd	4th	5th	6th
Points	40	35	30	26	22	20

**Championship & County shows** include USA-UK European Championships, AHPS (London Counties), Equifest, FBS Champs, BSPA WCoC, CHAPS-UK Champs etc. Plus any COUNTY show.

Category (b) **General & All Other Shows** Points Table

Place	1st	2nd	3rd	4th	5th	6th
Points	20	18	16	14	12	10

**General shows** include qualifiers for Championship shows, BSPA and CHAPS-UK affiliated shows, local shows etc.

**Championship Bonus Points** only applicable if entered into an In Hand or Ridden (Performance) Championship:  
Champion – 20 points, Reserve – 10 points, Second Reserve – 5 points

## Utility – In Hand and / or Ridden

Utility includes but is not limited to C&T, Best Rider, Family Mount, Best Colour Markings, Concours D'Elegance, Horsemanship, Western Riding, Western Reining (unless FEI affiliated) etc.

**Utility points do NOT count towards the Hi Points Ridden & In Hand rankings or your Horse's Championship Status – they have their OWN separate award (please still log your competitive results).**

## USA-UK KC Futurity Award – for Saddlebred Horses only 3 Years and Under

**Double Points** – any COUNTY show or ANY show 2 days or longer in duration

**Triple Points** – any SADDLEBRED specific class, any class at the MAY FESTIVAL show or any World Breed class in our ring at the EQUIFEST show.

ANY show that you have taken part in whilst showing your purebred or partbred Saddlebred in Saddlebred, Foreign Breeds (FB) or World Breed (WB) classes. Colour restricted classes do NOT count (e.g. palomino, coloured).

***Record where you have come in your in hand class only (the points will be calculated for both the in hand award and the futurity award).***

## USA-UK State Pleasure Award – Hunter, Western, 3-Gaited and 5-Gaited & Harness (driving) Divisions – for Saddlebreds only.

Points	6	5	4	3	2	1

ANY show that you have taken part in whilst competing Hunter/Western/3-Gaited or 5-Gaited in Ridden/Harness Saddlebred, Ridden Foreign Breeds (FB) or Ridden World Breed (WB) classes.

**Double Points** – any COUNTY show or ANY show 2 days or longer in duration

**Triple Points** – any SADDLEBRED specific class, and any class at the MAY FESTIVAL show or any World Breed class in our ring at the EQUIFEST show.

***Record where you have come in your ridden/harness class only (the points will be calculated for both the ridden award and the state pleasure awards).***

## USA-UK Sport Horse Award – Show Jumping, Dressage, Eventing (affiliated & unaffiliated) – for Saddlebreds only.

*Points in this category count towards your ridden score.*

## Endurance – Pleasure Rides, Competitive Rides & Endurance

(Conversion factor for miles: 1 km = 0.6214 miles – do **NOT** round up, use the full 4 decimal places)

### Point Scoring System:

Category (a) **Pleasure rides** up to 50km (30 miles): 1 point per km / 0.6214 points permile.

Category (b) **Competitive Rides** (any competitive ride where there are speed and vet controls): 0.5 points per km for 20 - 40 km rides, 1 point per km for 40 - 80 km rides, 1.5 km for 80 - 160 km rides. **PLUS** Points per grading: 1 – 40 points, 2 – 30 points, 3 – 20 points, 4 - 10 points

Category (c) **Endurance rides (80 km - 160 km)**: 1.5 points per km **PLUS** any placing points : 1<sup>st</sup> 40 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> 35 points, 3<sup>rd</sup> 30 points, 4<sup>th</sup> 26 points, 5<sup>th</sup> 22 points, 6<sup>th</sup> 20points

Category (d) **FEI affiliated: Points** 1<sup>st</sup> 100 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> 90 points, 3<sup>rd</sup> 80 points, 4<sup>th</sup> 70 points, 5<sup>th</sup> 60 points, 6<sup>th</sup> 50 points

*Points in this category count towards your ridden score.*

### Remember:

- Once your horse is registered with us (USAUK) he/she is registered for life.
- Points can only accumulate year from year once your horse is registered with us. Exhibitors also have to be members (at the time of horse earning points) for the points to be accumulative. Non registered horses, shown by non-members, taking part in the Hi-Point Awards will have their score reset to zero at the beginning of each year.
- The season runs from 1<sup>st</sup> January to 31<sup>st</sup> December.
- Completed Hi-Points should be returned by 30<sup>th</sup> January and the correct remittance made (made payable to USA-UK please).

- SASH Awards (Show Awards for Saddlebred/Show Horses) are made to each horse on the accumulative points – 1,000 points equates to Bronze level, 2,500 to Silver level and 5,000 points Gold level and the allocation of CHAMPION status. Points will be deemed gained upon return of the Hi-Point Books each year. Horses MUST be USAUK registered and shown by USAUK members in order to take part in the SASH Awards.
- Bronze Award – 1,000 points and certificate awarded.
- Silver Award – 2,500 points and certificate awarded.
- Gold Award – 5,000 points. Certificate awarded, presentation of SASH Award and prefix CH added to horses name.
- Elite Award – 10,000 points – Embroidered rug and allowance to use “Elite” status in conjunction with horse in question.
- All awards will be made at our Annual General Meeting and Conference.
